
Changing the silicone tube cut-off for Schilling burettes (Art.-no. 1 068, 1 069)

- 1. Use a knife to cut off the glass discharge tip. Remove any silicone remains carefully.
- 2. Remove the 3 screws at the Fitting with outlet tap. The burette part with the silicone tube can be removed.
- 3. Cut off the old tube at the glass olive of the burette, carefully remove the remains.
- 4. Push the replacement tube back onto the olive.
- 5. Open the stopcock system by pressing and push the glass part through. Silicone tube cut-off must not be squeezed.
- 6. Retighten the screws and reinsert the glass discharge tip into the silicone tube.
